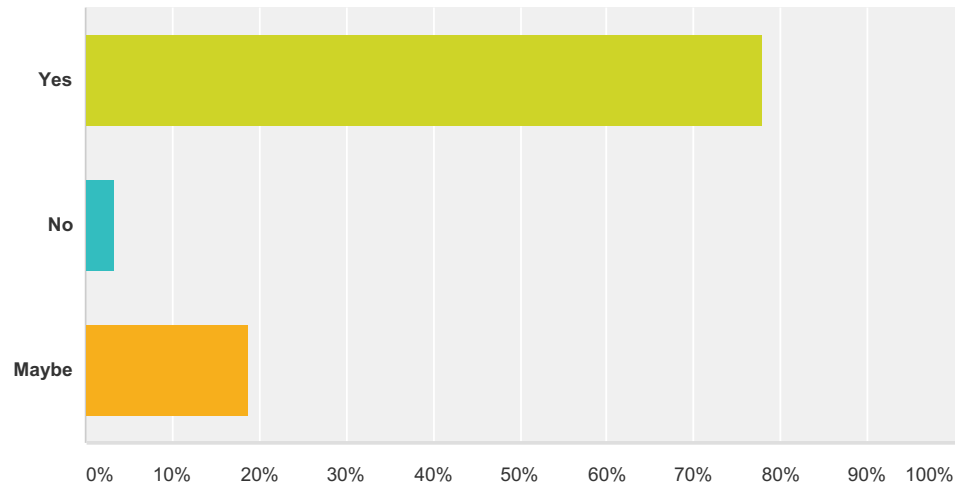


### Q1 Is there a need to do anything at the US Forest Service Managed Lower Breitenbush Hot Springs?

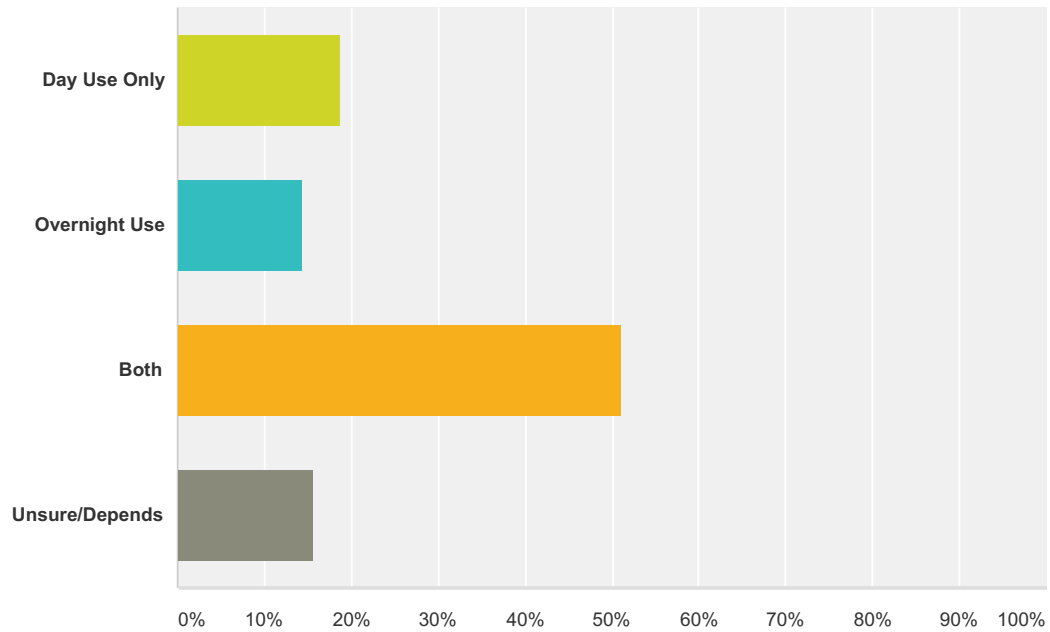

### Q2 Do you prefer facilities for day use or overnight use on the north side? (side without the hot tubs)

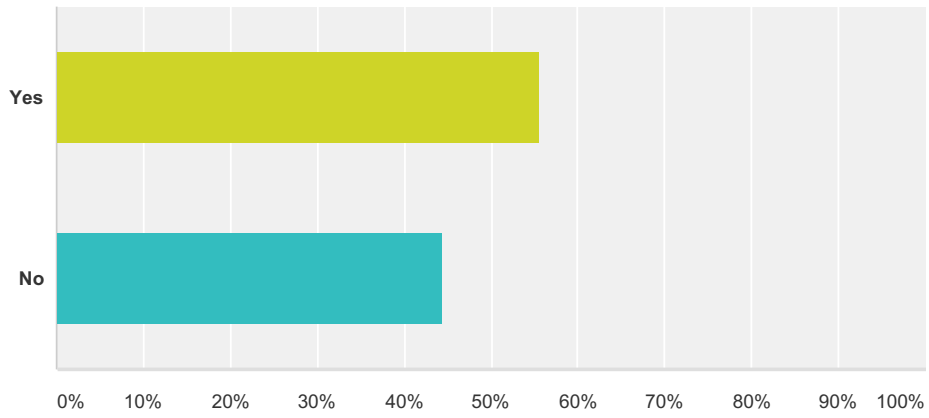

### Q3 Should there be overnight use at the hot springs site? (south side of the river)

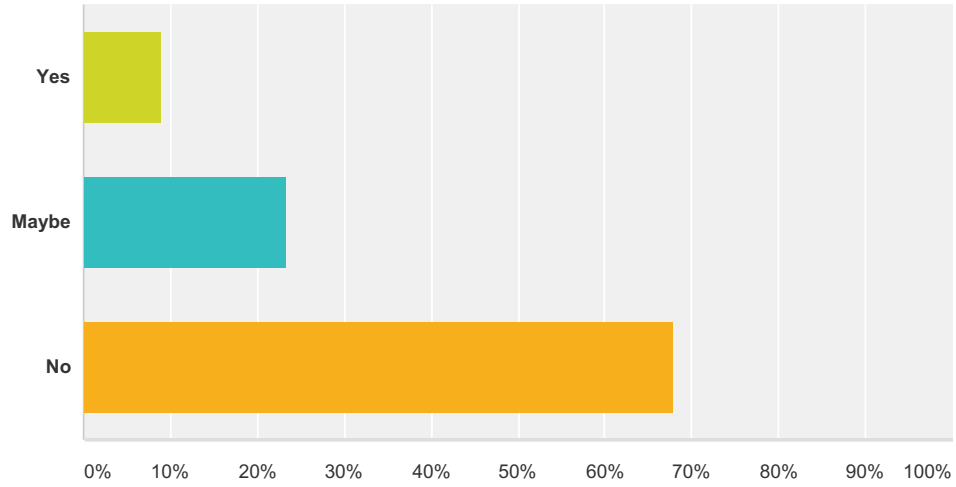

### Q4 Should the Lower Breitenbush Hot Springs be restored to its natural state prior to historic development and do everything to minimize the use of the site?

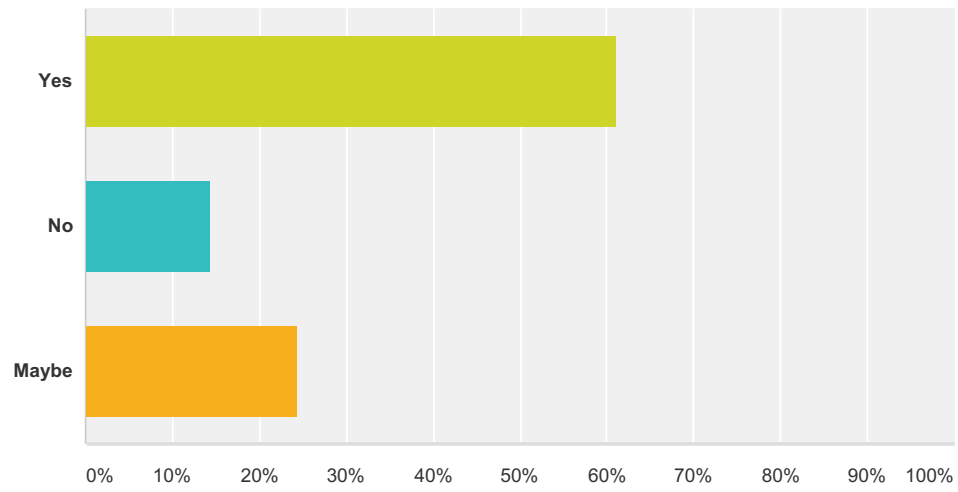

### Q5 Do we need to build a bridge to connect the north and south sides of the river?

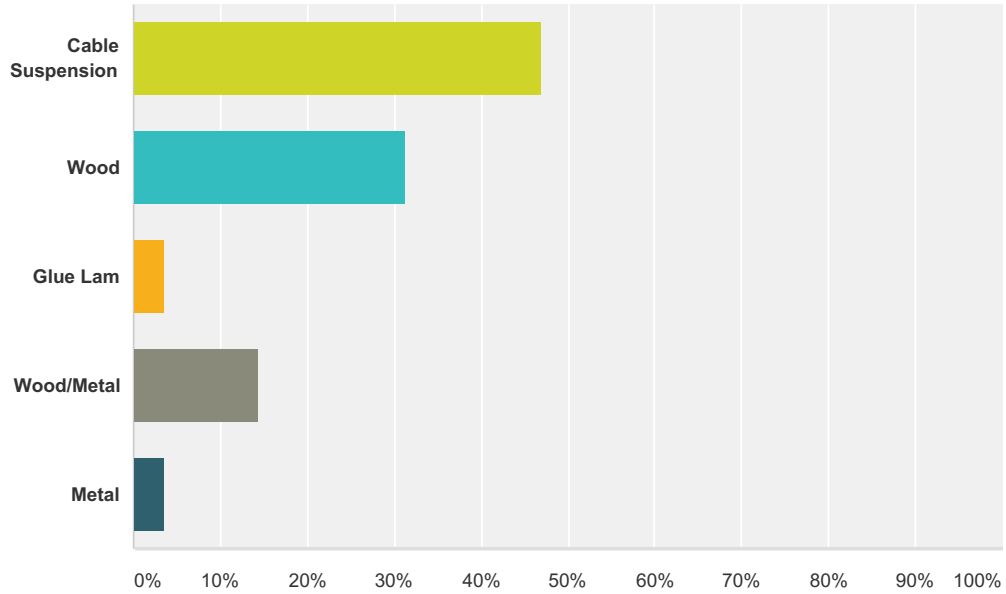

### Q6 If a bridge was built to connect the north and south sides of the river, what should the bridge look like?

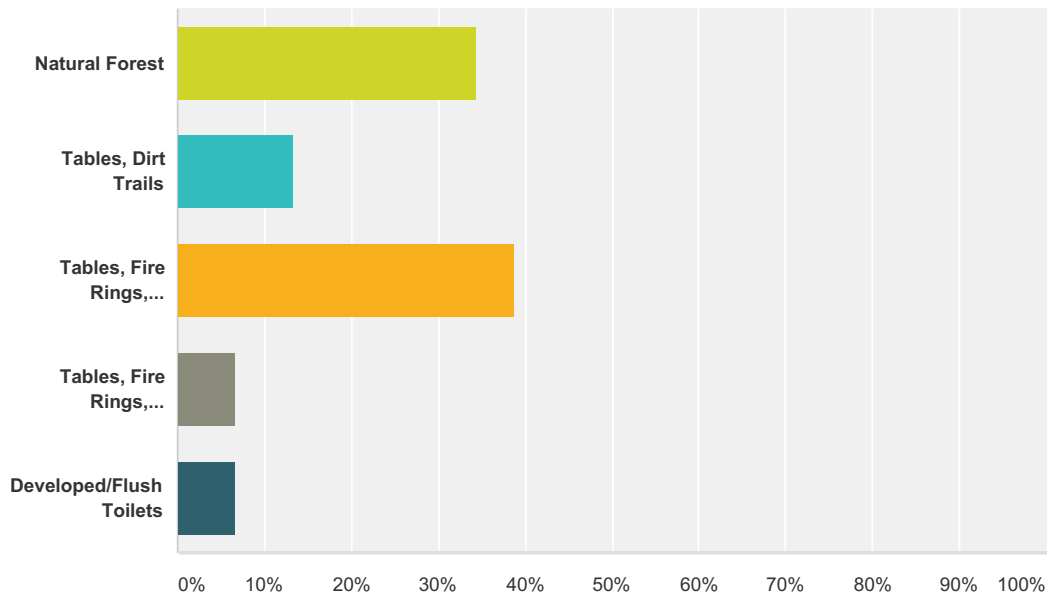

### Q7 Day Use: How would you like the area to look?

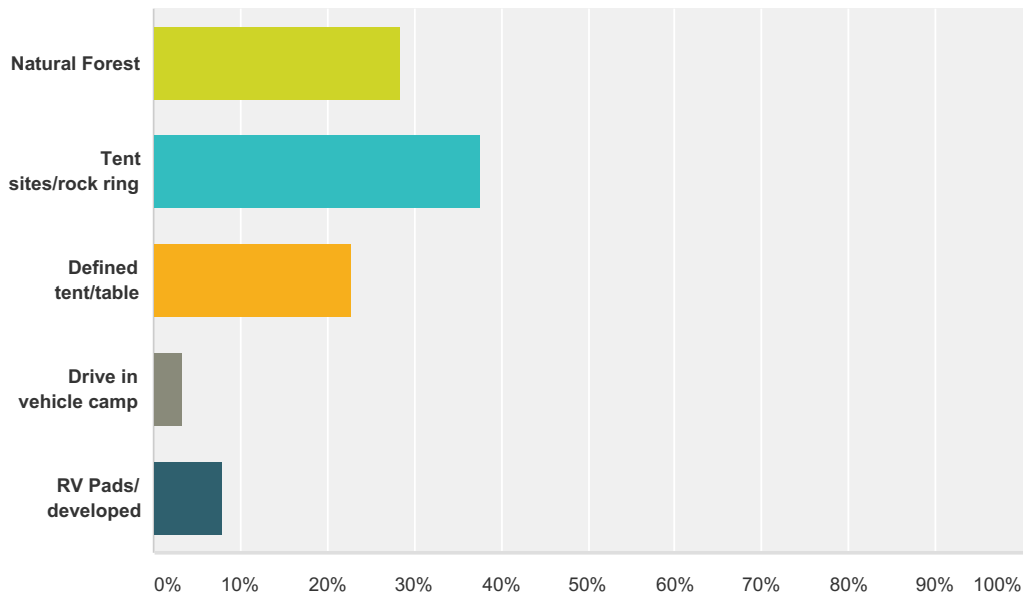

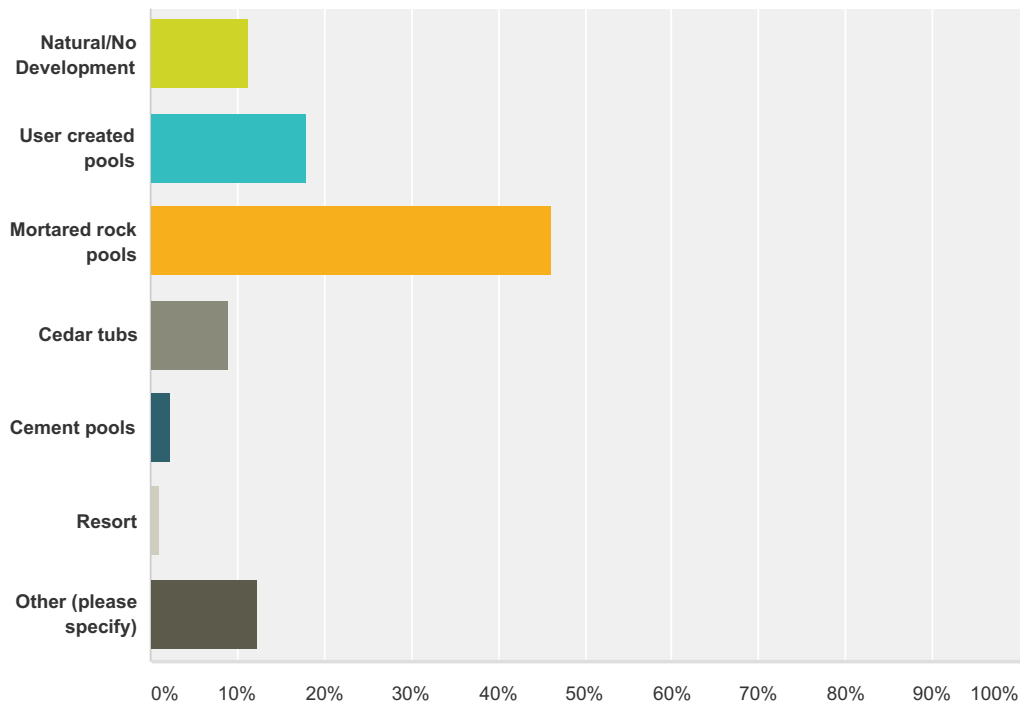

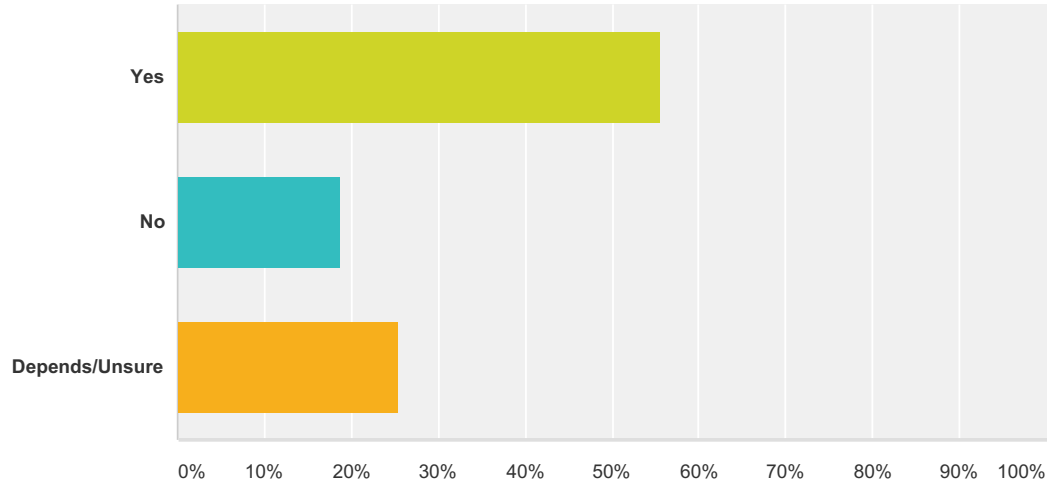
